



Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Between

UNIVERSITY OF ISFAHAN (I. R. IRAN)

And

KEIMYUNG UNIVERSITY (REPUBLIC OF KOREA)

Recognizing the importance of academic research and technological cooperation between universities and research centers for achieving engagement of academic members and researchers in the domain of science and technology and in order to expand the academic relationships, the University of Isfahan and the Keimyung University have agreed on the following subjects:

- 1- To facilitate the exchange of academic members, researchers and experts for conducting research, teaching or exchange of ideas.
- 2- To provide opportunities for professors and researchers to participate in conferences, symposiums and international meetings of both universities.
- 3- To provide necessary facilities for exchange professors to spend their sabbatical leaves in each of the two universities.
- 4- To collaborate in holding joint scientific, research and technological exhibitions and conducting joint research projects.
- 5- To collaborating in establishing dual degree programs and joint schools
- 6- To exchange students in the areas of mutual interest and offering scholarships and fellowships to the students consistent with regulations of both countries.
- 7- To exchange information, books, academic publications, scientific and research documents, students' thesis, microfilms and computer software in the educational, research and technological areas.

- 8- To facilitate visit of academic members, researchers, and students of both universities.
- 9- To provide facilities for participation of students in sport competitions.
- 10- To promote teaching and learning program(programs for teaching & learning methods)
- 11- The Keimyung University announces its readiness to admit the students of the University of Isfahan in Korean language programs.
- 12- The University of Isfahan announces its readiness to admit the students of the Keimyung University in Persian language programs.
- 13- The financing of any of the above mentioned activities shall be subjected to mutual agreements.
- 14- Within the framework of this M.O.U. of Cooperation, both parties can set further executive programs to agree upon the execution of the mutual agreement.
- 15- This M.O.U. shall remain valid for five years and shall be automatically extended for a similar term, unless any party notifies the other, six months in advance, its written intention to terminate it.

16- This M.O.U. has been signed on May 19, 2017 in 2 copies and in English all of which are equally authentic and shall come into force upon the signature of both parties.
